Burglary in the Willowdale Area

Yesterday around noon, perpetrators who are believed to be responsible for the previous three burglaries we reported recently forcibly entered a home in the 600 block of Willowdale Boulevard in Luling, Louisiana. Shortly thereafter, the homeowner returned and the burglars fled in a light grey (almost white) Toyota car with Missouri License Plates on the front and rear of the car. A white female about 5'2" with black hair in her mid twenties was acting as a lookout in the suspected vehicle. The burglar- a white male ran from behind the home and the pair was able to flee the scene on Willowdale Blvd heading north towards Highway 90. Items they were attempting to steal were dropped near the back door.

A neighbor also reported seeing a grey pickup truck (unknown license plate info) in the area possibly working with the suspects. Ironically, detectives in an unmarked vehicle had passed in the area ten minutes prior.

Anyone with any information concerning these burglaries are asked to contact Det. Donald Smith at 985-783-1135 or 911. The Sheriff's Office is asking for anyone who may have video surveillance in the Willowdale/Willowridge area to please contact the Sheriff's Office at the numbers listed above.

Sheriff Champagne is asking for vigilance and to not confine suspicion to the vehicle's described. The perpetrators may be working as a ring.

All available manpower is being dedicated toward the effort to identify and apprehend these individuals.
