Sheriff Greg Champagne reports that at approximately 2040 hours yesterday officers were dispatched to Turtle Creek in St. Rose for shots fired in the area. Upon arrival officers discovered a man slumped over inside a vehicle, which was still running. The victim, Jared C. Mealey, 19 years old of St. Rose, Louisiana had been shot and had no vital signs at the time of officers' arrival. The victim, who appeared to have been shot in the neck and face area was pronounced dead at the scene. This incident is under investigation. Anyone with any information is asked to contact Det.
