Hunter Safety Training



St. Charles Parish Sheriff Greg Champagne is offering Hunter Education classes. State law requires that all individuals born on or after September 1, 1969 to obtain a hunter education certificate card prior to purchasing a hunting license in Louisiana. Individuals must be ten years of age or older to be certified.



The course will cover such topics as firearm safety, survival, first aid, and wildlife identification.



The classes will be held at the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Firing Range located on LA 3127 in Killona behind the Nelson Coleman Correctional Facility.



Class size limited to 30 students. Each student must pre-register and attend both days.
