Sheriff Greg Champagne reports that on October 6, 2013, the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office along with the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office began investigating a St. Rose juvenile after he allegedly made threats of mass violence to a high school in Fayetteville, North Carolina. Through the investigation it was learned that the juvenile made threats in a chat room to shoot students at the North Carolina High School, naming particular students in the threat. Once questioned by officers the juvenile allegedly admitted to making the threats in order to see the reaction of the students in the chat room. The juvenile obtained the students names from a social media account to make them think the threat was real. On October 8, 2013, the juvenile was arrested on a warrant for Terrorizing. The juvenile was arrested and booked accordingly and is being held on a \$100,000 bond at the Assumption Juvenile Detention Center.
