Sheriff Greg Champagne reports that the above subject turned himself in on a warrant that was issued in 2013 for the above charges. In 2012, officers received information that Scott had a large amount of illegal drugs hidden in an empty lot on Paul Fredrick St. In the empty lot officers located: approximately 35.7 grams of Crack Cocaine, approximately 6.4 grams of Powder Cocaine, approximately 3.8 grams of Heroin, approximately 5.8 grams of Bath Salts, a Digital Weight Scale, and approximately 405.3 grams of Marijuana. Due to the information received, officers secured a search warrant for Scott's DNA. In January of 2013, the Louisiana State Police Crime Lab's Report stated that Scott's DNA was found on some of the illegal narcotics. Based on the information received from the Crime Lab a warrant was issued for Scott for the above charges. Subsequent attempts to locate Scott yielded negative results. Through information received, it was believed that Scott had fled to California in order to avoid prosecution.

Today, at approximately 0308 hours Scott turned himself in to the Nelson Coleman Correctional Center. Scott is being held on a \$150,000 bond set by Judge Lemmon.
