Arrest Made for Attempted Second Degree Murder June 29, 2016

On June 28, 2016 at 2:54 PM. Chad Lloyd Guillot, a 35 year old male of 148 Ormond Village Drive in Destrehan, LA, was arrested for Attempted Second Degree Murder, Carrying of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, Possession with Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine, Possession of a Firearm in the Presence of a CDS, and Illegal Use of a CDS in Presence of a Juvenile.

On June 28, 2016 at approximately 3:35 AM, the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office was notified of a burglary in progress at 106 Church Hill Downs in Montz, LA. During the investigation, detectives learned that Chad Guillot and the residence owner arrived at the residence on Church Hill Downs in Montz, LA. Upon entering the residence, they confronted Daniel Villa who did not have permission to be at the residence. Daniel Villa fled the residence while allegedly armed with a firearm. Chad Guillot chased after Daniel Villa. Daniel Villa entered his vehicle and was attempting to flee when Chad Guillot re-engaged and shot Daniel Villa. Daniel Villa was taken to the hospital where it was determined that his injury was non-life threatening.

During the course of the investigation, a search warrant was executed on Chad Guillot's vehicle where 4.4 grams of Methamphetamine was discovered. Due to the circumstances of the incident, Chad Guillot was arrested for the mentioned criminal charges. This investigation is on-going and further charges are pending.
