On the evening of January 6, 2016, Damani Wells turned himself into the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office. Mr. Wells was then booked into the Nelson Coleman Correctional Center. Mr. Wells was booked with two counts of First Degree Robbery and two counts of Attempted First Degree Robbery related to this incident.

The St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office is still actively seeking the location of Antonio Payne and Tyran Joseph. Anyone with knowledge of their whereabouts is asked to contact St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office Detective Holly Laurent at (985)783-1135 or (985)783-6807.

The robbery occurred on Thursday, January 5, 2016 near Plantation Road in Destrehan, Louisiana. Three suspects, Tyran Joseph, Damani Wells, and Antonio Payne approached the victims and implied that they were armed with a weapon. The three suspects then took cellphones and a wallet from the victims before battering the victims, then fleeing the area on foot.

The two suspects remaining at large are as follows:

Suspect 1:

Antonio Payne, a black male, 20 years of age.

Approximately 6'01" tall and 175 lbs.

Suspect 2:

Tyran Joseph, a black male, 22 years of age.

Approximately 5'09" tall and 160 lbs.
