<b>CHGS: Obstruction of Justice, Principal to Second Degree Murder, Felony Carrying Illegal Weapons</b>	
<p>Sheriff Greg Champagne reports on May 18, 2018 the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office responded to a complaint of a shooting which occurred in the 1000 block of Paul Fredrick Street in Luling, Louisiana. Shortly after arriving on scene, investigators learned that the victim, Savahn Stewart, a 19 year old resident of Luling, Louisiana, had been fatally wounded.</p> <p>It was also learned that a suspect involved in the incident, Leonard Celestine, had fled the scene in a vehicle. A detective responding to the scene observed the vehicle allegedly occupied by Leonard Celestine and was able to affect a stop with the vehicle on Interstate 310 North Bound. The driver of the vehicle, Leonard Celestine, and the passenger of the vehicle, Jerry Celestine, were both taken into custody.</p> <p>Throughout the investigation, it was learned that after a confrontation between Leonard Celestine and Savahn Stewart, Leonard Celestine allegedly shot Savahn Stewart. Savahn Stewart was taken to St. Charles Hospital where he died from his injury. Leonard Celestine and his brother Jerry Celestine were apprehended and arrested in relation to the incident.</p>
