Sheriff Greg Champagne reports Detectives attempted to conduct a traffic stop with a vehicle driven by Strickland. As a detective attempted to exit his vehicle, Strickland attempted to drive away, forcing the detective to dive away from Strickland's vehicle to avoid being struck. After a brief vehicle pursuit, Strickland exited his vehicle and attempted to flee on foot but was apprehended.

Detectives recovered drug paraphernalia and a package containing what is believed to be synthetic cannabinoids. The suspected synthetic cannabinoids were sent to a lab for testing. Additional charges may be filed pending the results of the lab testing.
