DETECTIVES WITH THE ST. CHARLES PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE ARREST TWO MORE JUVENILES FOR CRIMES COMMITTED IN NORCO

Luling, Louisiana March 1, 2024:

The St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office announces the arrests of a seventeen-year-old male and a fifteen-year-old male from the New Orleans area for multiple crimes that occurred in Norco during the overnight hours of February 20, 2024. These arrests are in addition to the arrest of a fourteen-year-old male from the New Orleans area that was announced yesterday, February 29, 2024.

A resident in the 500 block of Giacomo Street in Norco reported that someone stole two vehicles from their driveway. Both vehicles were located in New Orleans on the same day.

A resident in the 600 block of Giacomo Street in Norco reported that someone entered his vehicle and rummaged through the inside.

A resident in the 500 block of Fourth Street in Norco reported that someone entered her vehicle and stole two vapes.

A resident in the 500 block of Spruce Street in Norco reported that someone entered her vehicle and stole personal items.

A resident in the 600 block of Pine Street in Norco reported that someone entered her vehicle and rummaged through the inside.

Video surveillance during these crimes showed a black four-door vehicle stop in front of the residences. That vehicle was found abandoned in the Norco area and was confirmed stolen from a nearby parish.

Through investigation, sufficient evidence was gathered to arrest the juveniles for all the above crimes.

Sheriff Champagne is proud of the hard work of Detective Charles Floyd and assisting Detectives. Their dedication to the citizens of St. Charles Parish helps keep our parish a safe place to live and work.

This is still an active and ongoing investigation and detectives are looking into other crimes possibly committed in St. Charles Parish.
