SHERIFF CHAMPAGNE ANNOUNCES SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

Sheriff Greg Champagne announced that Courtney Speice, of St. Charles Parish has been named the recipient of an academic scholarship from the Louisiana Sheriffs' Scholarship Program.

Courtney, graduated from Hahnville High School in May and will be attending University of Louisiana at Lafayette in the fall. She will be majoring in Chemical Engineering. Courtney is the daughter of John and Ellen Speice of Des Allemands.

Made possible by the Louisiana Sheriffs' Honoree Membership Program (LSHMP), Louisiana Sheriffs' provide scholarships to graduating high school students from each parish where the Sheriff is an affiliate of the Program. The only limitations are that applicants be permanent residents of Louisiana, scholarships be utilized in higher education within the State, and students be enrolled as full-time, undergraduate students. Scholarships will be awarded in fifty-six parishes throughout the State.

Amanda Palamone of Luling was named as an alternate so that in the event the recipient is unable to take advantage of the scholarship award; the alternate can do so, according to the Sheriff.

“Academic awards by the Louisiana Sheriffs' Scholarship Program to Louisiana students best demonstrate what the LSHMP is all about. This is one of our proudest accomplishments. Simply, it is a means of investing in Louisiana's future. And this would not be possible without the generosity of St. Charles Parish's Honorary members and others throughout the state,” concluded Sheriff Champagne.
