EXECUTION OF SEARCH WARRANT LEADS TO ARRESTS AND SEIZURE OF FIREARMS AND ILLICIT NARCOTICS

On Wednesday, August 14, 2024, members of the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office, along with an ATF Task Force Officer, conducted a narcotics investigation that led to the issuance of a search warrant at 247 Canal Street in Luling (Delicate Touch Carwash).

While attempting to execute the search warrant, 52-year-old Tara Coburn refused to cooperate with the investigation and exit the residence. Due to the lack of cooperation and safety concerns, the SWAT team was requested and deployed to the location to assist. A few hours later, the subject exited peacefully and without incident to SWAT team members. Once it was safe to do so, investigators executed the search warrant and seized the following:

- 9 individual baggies containing approximately 12.19 grams of green-vegetable matter
- 37 dosage units of MDMA tablets (approximately 14.17 grams)
- 1 dosage unit of Hydrocodone
- 1 Glock 9mm Model 43 handgun
- 1 Taurus 9mm Model G2C handgun (not pictured)
- 1 black Taurus 9mm Model G2C handgun



In all, three individuals, 52-year-old Tara Coburn of Luling, 32-year-old Darryl Davis of Boutte, and 29-year-old Kenneth Baker of Luling, were arrested on narcotics and weapon charges. They were transported to the Nelson Coleman Correctional Center and booked accordingly.
