The St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office reports contact was made with Scott during a traffic stop. While speaking with Scott, deputies detected the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle and Scott. Deputies discovered that Scott had placed marijuana in his mouth to allegedly conceal the narcotics. Scott was taken into custody and booked accordingly.
