HABITUAL OFFENDERS ARRESTED IN LULING AFTER FLEEING FROM DEPUTIES

On Wednesday, June 5, 2025, while on active patrol, deputies observed a man sitting in front of a residence on the 1000 block of Luling Estates Drive. They immediately recognized him as 23-year-old Jalen Downing, who they knew had an active arrest warrant. When the deputies attempted to make contact with him, he fled on foot. The deputies pursued him, and at one point during the foot chase, he entered a residence on the 1000 block of Kinler Street. Downing eventually surrendered to the deputies a short time later. He was arrested for Resisting an Officer and for an outstanding fugitive warrant from another agency. Additionally, he faced charges of Battery of a Dating Partner and Simple Criminal Damage to Property, which were related to the outstanding warrant.

Several hours later, deputies were dispatched to the intersection of Hackberry Street and Kinler Street in Luling due to reports of a male standing in the middle of the street, swinging a metal pole and yelling at passing individuals. Upon their arrival, deputies encountered 24-year-old Jaden Robertson, who fled on foot shortly after making contact with him.

The deputies pursued Robertson through Luling Estates, then onto Gassen Street, and eventually into the Ashton neighborhood. He ultimately surrendered to the deputies in the 100 block of Cove Point Drive in Luling. Robertson was arrested for Disturbing the Peace and Resisting an Officer.
