On the early morning hours of January 11, 2017 near approximately 1210 A.M. the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office responded to an armed robbery which occurred at a Birdie's Food and Fuel at 1900 Ormond Blvd in Destrehan, Louisiana.

During the investigation, detectives were able to obtain a still image captured from video footage inside of the store. The St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office is asking for the public's help in identifying the armed subject (refer to photograph).

The subject is described as a white male, approximately 18 to 21 years of age, approximately 5'9" to 5'10 in height, with a thin build. The subject was clad in a camouflage face mask, a navy colored t-shirt over a fitted black long sleeve shirt, and dark gray or black jeans.
