Sheriff Greg Champagne would like your assistance in identifying a subject involved in a robbery that was committed on June 21, 2018 around 10:30 p.m.

Detectives of the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office are investigating a robbery that occurred at 13470 River Road in Destrehan, LA, The Big River Food and Fuel Shell Station. A suspect, described as a young black male, thin build, between 5'7" to 5'10" tall, entered the Shell Station clad in an "I (heart symbol) NY" hooded sweatshirt, grey sweatpants with a tear at the knees, and yellow dishwashing gloves. The suspect was holding a handgun in his left hand, and ordered money from the cashier. The cashier opened the cash register till, and the suspect took several hundred dollars from the register before fleeing the scene.

Witnesses believed to have seen the suspect fleeing over a fence, leading towards Meadows Drive in Destrehan, LA.
