The St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office is seeking the public's assistance in locating a 15-year-old female runaway.

On Saturday, August 27, 2022, Aubrey Parker exited her friend's residence in Luling, LA and did not return home. Aubrey told her friend a "cousin" was picking her up. Aubrey's mother contacted the Sheriff's Office and reported her as a runaway when she failed to return.

Through investigation, detectives learned Aubrey was trying to find a ride home from an unknown address in LaPlace on Sunday, August 28, 2022.

Aubrey Parker is described as a white female with brown hair and hazel eyes. She is approximately 4'5" tall, and weighs approximately 80 lbs.
